

**Marilynn Etzel Scholarship Fund  
Rules and Regulations**

1. In 2011, the Iowa Composers Forum will select one student to receive a \$500 scholarship to help the student defray the costs of studying music at an Iowa College or University. The check will be made out to the college (not the student).
2. All entrants must include as part of their application a complete score for an original composition that they have created (arrangements are not acceptable). Entrants may also submit a recording of this piece, though one is not required.
3. All entrants must fill out the entry form on the subsequent page. Entries that do not have a completed entry form will not be considered. The quality of the answers to the entry form will be considered with the application.
4. On June 1, 2011, entrants must either be a:
  - a) Senior in High School
  - b) Freshman in College
  - c) Sophomore in College
  - d) Junior in College
5. Entrants must be under the age of 23.
6. Entrants must be accepted and enrolled in an Iowa College or University for the 2011-2012 academic year. (Both public and private colleges are eligible).
7. Entrants must have declared a major of music for the 2011-2012 academic year.
8. Entrants must be a resident of the state of Iowa.
9. The student winning the scholarship will be required to become a student member of the Iowa Composers Forum. The current student membership fee is \$20.
10. The Iowa Composers Forum will Declare a Winner of the scholarship competition by July 1, 2011.

To enter the competition, submit a copy of the entry form and one score to an original composition composed by the entrant. Items should be mailed by a postmark deadline of **June 1, 2011** to:
